4. Budget overview and take any action necessary for 2016-2017 budget. (Judge Riley)

Judge Kelly Greene, presented information to the court. Requested an additional employee for the 2016-2017 budget year. Stated his staff is overwhelmed.

Commissioner Walden asked if \$41,000.00 was total cost or just salary. Judge replied that it's just salary.

Commissioner Conley asked how many days of the week are the clerks overwhelmed. Judge Greene replied about 3 days. Workload is not going to decrease, it will only increase.

Commissioner Dugan asked if Judge has considered part time help.

Commissioner Peacock asked how many clerks are in other offices.

Gina Osborn, Elections, requested one new full time employee for the 2016-2017 budget year. Would give up a part time position for one new full time employee totaling \$46,795.00 annually.

Commissioner Conley asked how many full time positions are currently in elections.

Judge Riley presented information to the court.

John Forrest, County Attorney requested to change office manager to CPS attorney. Request to reclassify the position. CPS cases have doubled. Increase Salary to \$70,044.00 currently at \$57,000.08

John Forrest, County Attorney second request: County Attorney Legal Clerks are on the low end of the pay scale as compared to other clerks in the county. He stated they are paid about \$5,000.00 less. County Attorney request to increase legal clerk pay to be equal to other clerks.

Judge Riley reported that the Sheriff's office is going to request a new clerk.

Mike Rhoten, Auditor state that there is money available in the proposed for a 3% for all employees and 3.5% for guns and badges.

Jenny Gentry, presented information to the court. She submitted a chart showing new insurance cost.

Motion was made by Judge Riley and seconded by Commissioner Peacock to approve the recommended cost for health insurance for employees and employer cost as presented. Submitted.
