**1. Public Hearing on proposed 2016-2017 budget. PUBLIC HEARING (Judge Riley)**

Public Hearing was opened at 9:05a.m.

Judge Riley presented information to the court concerning management of shift 86 hours. Requested input from Constables.

Constable Harris presented information to the court.

Constable Nix presented information to the court.

Jenny Gentry, Benefits coordinator presented information to the court.

Commissioner Walden presented information to the court.

County Attorney, John Forrest, presented information to the court.

**3. Vote on order to set Parker County General Fund and Lateral Road tax for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. (Judge Riley)**

Motion was made by Judge Riley and seconded by Commissioner Conley to approve property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a total tax rate of .41865068 cents which is the total effective tax rate. This tax rate will effectively increase taxes for Road and Bridge maintenance and operations from last year's rate by 10.662 % and will increase taxes on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$8.18. The tax rate for each fund is as follows:

General fund rate: .2637798  
Lateral Road .0848708  
Debt Service Rate which includes voter approved bond debt .070
