**ORDER OR09-08**

WHEREAS, on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 2009, the Commissioners Court of Parker County, Texas, in special meeting, considered the following matter:

Whether to prohibit or otherwise regulate the discharge of firearms on lots that are 10 acres or smaller and are located in the unincorporated area of the county in a subdivision.

AND having considered said matter, finds:

That prohibiting the discharge of firearms on lots that are 10 acres or smaller and are located in the unincorporated area of the county in a subdivision would promote public safety.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that :

The discharge of firearms on lots that are 10 acres or smaller and are located in the unincorporated area of the county in a platted subdivision is prohibited except for the protection of all personal property, self defense, livestock, and varmint extermination.

Additionally, a person commits a criminal offense if the person intentionally or knowingly engages in conduct that violates this order.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk of this Court shall place this order in the minutes of the Commissioners Court of Parker County, Texas.
