Update of COVID-19 information for Parker County, Texas

COVID-19 is not OVER! Some studies show that those that have not been vaccinated could be exposed to higher positivity rates potentially leading to more serious conditions.

ALL residents of Parker County, that are eligible, should consider getting the vaccine.

While it's likely that previous infection does provide some protection, it is not yet known how much protection a previous infection with COVID-19 provides. Studies have shown that vaccination provides a strong boost in protection in people who have recovered from COVID-19.

Current estimates in Parker County indicate that approximately 3 out of 10 people over the age of 65 are not fully vaccinated and approximately 6 out of 10 people over the age of 12 are not fully vaccinated.

The vaccines are free and there are many opportunities across Parker County to get the vaccines. The primary location to get the vaccine is the Parker County Hospital District (PCHD). You can also get the vaccine at multiple pharmacies in Parker County.

NO APPOINTMENT NEEDED FOR THE FIRST DOSE.

All first doses of COVID-19 vaccinations will be given at their walk-in clinic located at 712 E. Anderson St., Weatherford, TX 76086.
