Special Election:

Aledo ISD – Bond Vote For or Against

Proposition A: The issuance of \$123,800,000 of bonds by the Aledo Independent School District for the construction, renovation, acquisition and equipment of school facilities in the District (including, but not limited to, improvements to enhance safety and security), including the acquisition of land therefor and the acquisition of new school buses, and levying the tax in payment thereof. This is a property tax increase.

La emisión de \$123,800,000 en bonos por parte del Distrito Escolar Independiente de Aledo para la construcción, la renovación, la adquisición y el equipamiento de instalaciones escolares en el Distrito (como, entre otras cosas, mejoras para incrementar la seguridad y la protección), lo que incluye la adquisición de terrenos para las mismas y de buses escolares nuevos, y la imposición del impuesto en pago de los mismos. Este es un aumento del impuesto a la propiedad.

Brock ISD – Bond Vote For or Against

Proposition A: THE ISSUANCE OF \$49,800,000 OF BONDS FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES AND LEVYING THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. Proposition C: THE ISSUANCE OF \$700,000 OF BONDS FOR FOOTBALL STADIUM IMPROVEMENTS AND LEVYING THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE. *(LA EMISIÓN DE BONOS POR EL IMPORTE DE \$700,000 PARA MEJORAS AL ESTADIO DE FÚTBOL AMERICANO, Y LA IMPOSICIÓN DE IMPUESTOS PARA EL PAGO DE DICHOS BONOS. ESTO REPRESENTA UN INCREMENTO EN EL IMPUESTO PREDIAL.)*

Garner ISD – Bond Vote For or Against

“THE ISSUANCE OF \$15,400,000 OF BONDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENT, ACQUISITION, AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING A NEW CAFETERIA, KITCHEN, AND STORM SHELTER THAT WILL BE ADDED TO EXISTING FACILITIES, AND A NEW MULTIPURPOSE GYMNASIUM; AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS AND TO PAY THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED OR AUTHORIZED IN ANTICIPATION OF, IN RELATION TO, OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE BONDS; THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.”

Springtown ISD – Bond

Proposition A: The issuance of \$120,780,000 of bonds by the Springtown Independent School District for a new middle school campus; restroom renovations at the existing intermediate school and purchasing land for school buildings, and levying the tax in payment thereof. This is a property tax increase. *(La emisión de \$120,780,000 en bonos por parte del distrito escolar independiente de Springtown para un nuevo campus de escuela intermedia; renovaciones de baños en la escuela intermedia existente y compra de sitios para edificios escolares, y la imposición del impuesto para el pago de los bonos. Esto es un aumento al impuesto predial.)*

City of Cresson – Taxation Vote For or Against

Propositions A: The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in Cresson, Texas at the rate of ½% to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. The tax expires on the fourth anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of the tax is reauthorized. *(La reautorización del impuesto local sobre las ventas y el uso en Cresson, Texas a una tasa del 1/2% para continuar proporcionando ingresos para el mantenimiento y reparación de las calles municipales.
